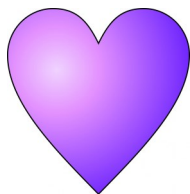
The week of September 13-19th, purchase a smile cookie from local FW Tim Horton Stores and 100% of the \$1 from your purchase will go to CWWD :)
