

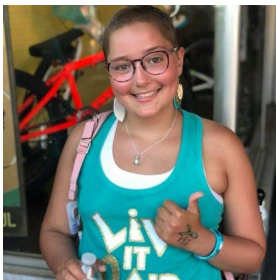

VIP Spotlight: Olivia (camper) and Michelle (volunteer)

Olivia Stoy is 15 years old and a freshman at Angola High School. On May 18, 2016 she was diagnosed with T-Lymphoblastic Lymphoma. Olivia enjoys basketball, softball, reading and spending time with her family and friends. Her treatment plan will take place over 3 years but this type of cancer offers a 95% success rate, that it will be treated and never return! When Olivia was originally diagnosed she had a large mass in her chest. On February 14, 2017 Olivia was found to be cancer free. In March of 2018 her cancer relapsed in the same spot as before. Olivia received a bone marrow transplant with her brother Preston being her donor in July 2018. The last 9 months Olivia has been isolated from the public because of her compromised immune system. She looks forward to being released by her doctors just in time to attend CWWD! She loves camp so much, it's what got her through the difficult days of her recovery!

Michelle Hoffman has been coming to CWWD since 2007 when she first came for just 1 day. Over the years, Michelle has been spending more and more time at camp: spending the night, helping with Kinder Camp Day, hosting a Teen Survivor Workshop, gaining insight at a Parent Workgroup session and going on the canoe trip. Michelle is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker at Lutheran Children's Hospital. She says her favorite part of camp is seeing kids be kids outside of the hospital environment and having the space and time to talk, listen and be silly with patients she's known for over a decade. Volunteering at camp is definitely a highlight of her summer. This year Michelle is coming to CWWD for the week and leading a new Journalism/Writing Skills Class. The goal is to produce CWWD's first newspaper filled with poems, stories, pictures and interviews that are written by the campers. Michelle hopes this can be a therapeutic experience for all of the campers.
